Good News Report

- Mr. Schlotman has shared with faculty and staff the architectural renderings of BCHS's new Arts/Music and the Field buildings as well as the plans for our current auditorium which will be converted into four classrooms (with retractable glass walls). He will send to SBDM members today. He also explained the entrances planned for the new arts building.
- These are projected to start sometime in September 2020.
- The school building's interior has been completely repainted in addition to extensive roof and brick repair. In the back of the building, every brick was re-grouted in hopes of preventing further water leakage into classrooms.
- Other building improvements: lines on the football field will be placed underground and new lockers are being installed on both first and second floors in the back hallways.
- Senior Activity "Speedway Victory Lap for Class of 2020," was well received by families and our seniors. Some even asked if it could be continued annually.
- The Drop Off/Pick Up day for underclassmen went well. There will probably be another day scheduled for this as there are still locker items to be picked up.
- Positive feedback on our virtual graduation was received. Diplomas that have not been picked up will be mailed.
- There is a possibility that some fall sports may begin on July 1<sup>st</sup> which would include Band. Right now, there is only conditioning for fall sports. Each activity must be monitored closely.
- Katie Webb and John Courtney were named members to the Regional Youth Leadership Class of 2021.

Budget Reports

- Budget Reports, distributed via email, were examined and discussed.
- Mrs. Wharton made a motion to approve the budgets; it was seconded by Miss Patterson.
- Mr. Schlotman noted that a couple of the accounts were still in the red; so, we will have to balance those. Those activities did not get to finish their seasons and/or fundraisers were

postponed or cancelled. The District is still waiting for the State to give guidelines on how to handle these situations.

- Mr. Turner think all will be fine school budget this year; though it all depends upon the State budget.

### New Business

Levels meetings with District leadership will be held each Wednesday (starting today) regarding beginning of next school year.

The following will be discussed at these meetings:

- School calendar modifications.
- The District will not pay faculty if they are not working. If school starts later than presently scheduled, it will be three weeks before the faculty will receive a pay check.
- One idea is for all PD days being “front loading” with teachers start on 10<sup>th</sup> and students starting a week later.
- A Hybrid plan.
- Grading issues.
- Another idea: Divide kids alphabetically--use zoom and teach the students are in front of the teacher with different days to attend.
- Parents who will not send kids to school until a vaccine is available.
- Many other issues to consider.
- The need for a relatively simple plan
