Good News Report

- Senior Activities went well: the Senior Parade around the school with a great response from the community, seniors, families, and the BCHS faculty; Baccalaureate evening; Awards Night (though there was some audio problem with the equipment), and Graduation ceremony with the gymnasium decorated as in the past. The filming of this with Mr. Neuhaus reading off the names with a power point featuring pictures of the seniors and their names scrolling across the screen is being edited now. It will be aired this Friday at 7 P.M.
- Mr. Melching organized and filmed the Virtual College signing Night.
- Mr. Poe was scheduled to give the graduation speech as he is retiring and he worked at BCHS before becoming superintendent. His speech has been videotaped and will be dropped into the graduation presentation.
- Another senior activity is possible for the end of this week which is awaiting District approval.
- Drop Off/Pick Up day for seniors went well. There were three areas--the Commons, the Main Office, and the gym--for students to stop. 311 seniors showed out of the total 340. All were cooperative bringing items back.

Soon information will be sent out to underclassmen to pick up their locker belongings. It is possible they will keep the loaned chrome books until the fall in case they may need them at home again.

Next week, District meetings are scheduled to discuss what next fall will it look like.

Budget Reports

- Budget Reports, distributed via email, were examined.
- The District is still discussing how to handle individual sports/club budget accounts that are in the red at the end of June. Unfortunately, a number of spring fundraisers were postponed or cancelled due to the closing of schools. The State is being asked to relax some of the Red Book guidelines.

Mrs. Birkenhauer made a motion to approve the budgets; seconded by Mrs. Wharton.

Master Schedule Approval

- Arranging common planning schedules for core teachers worked out pretty well; though as suspected, some instructors will have a single subject-type schedule. Having common planning for core teachers is a District initiative.
- The scheduling button was pushed yesterday; we are ahead of the game since counselors have worked on student schedules.
- Discussion followed.

Room assignments are not on the master schedule; therefore, SBDM will approve these at a later date. The number of classroom available next year will be an issue, because of the construction of the new building (removing 2 trailers with 4 classrooms) and revamping the auditorium (chorus and theater classes). As a result, there is a loss of approximately seven classrooms for next year.
