Dear Parents and Students,

In 2012, Boone County Schools aligned their unweighted GPA calculation to meet the requirements specified in KEES Regulation 11 KAR 15.090, which required students' unweighted GPA's to be calculated using a 4.0 scale. In order to ensure that the weighted GPA remains "equal to" or "greater than" students' unweighted GPA, an alignment of the weighted GPA scale was necessary.

All students' transcripts for the 2014-15 school year will reflect the following **weighted** grade scale:

Weighted GPA for AP/Dual Credit Courses	
94-108	5.0
87-93	4.0
78-86	3.0
70-77	2.0
0-69	1.0
Weighted GPA for Honor Courses	
94-104	4.5
87-93	3.5
78-86	2.5
70-77	1.5
0-69	.5

*(Weighted courses posted to transcript prior to the 2014-15 school year will reflect the alignment.)
