National Board Certifications

Originally established in 1987 National Board's founding funders and stakeholders envisioned a structure for education professionals just like the structure for professions such as law and medicine where practitioners have a primary role in determining standards of entry, practice and advancement. National Board Certification (NBC) is a voluntary, advanced teaching credential that goes beyond state licensure. NBC has national standards for what accomplished educators should know and be able to do. The National Board certifies educators who successfully complete its rigorous certification process.
