Dear Students and Parents:

Boone County High School will be holding summer school from May 31 – June 23. Summer school will be IN-PERSON ONLY and will take place from 7:30 – 11:30. The first week (May 31 – June 3), Summer School will run Tuesday through Friday. Every week after will be Monday through Thursday.

Bus transportation will be provided. Additional information regarding transportation will be released close to the start of summer school. Additional afternoon hours may be offered. A daily bag lunch will be provided free of charge to all students. Edgenuity will be utilized for all courses assigned. If your child failed one or more classes this year, or is not on grade level, this is a great opportunity to recover the class credit. Students may take one or more classes in summer school, but only one class at a time. The sequence of courses taken will be determined by your child's designated school counselor. There is NO charge for summer school this year.

Students are required to be in-person every day. Excessive absences (more than three) will result in dismissal from the program. Students will be assigned a caseload teacher based upon the course they are currently working on. This teacher will be the contact for students and their legal guardians. Outside resources should not be used or accessed while completing an Edgenuity course. Only those directly linked to Edgenuity should be utilized. Students are required to take notes while watching the videos and are encouraged to use these notes as a study tool. Finally, only the students assigned to the course should be accessing it through their personal "Clever" account.

Students who do not adhere to the summer school program guidelines or violate the Boone County School's Code of Conduct may be dismissed from the program at any time.
